## PROVISION OF INFORMATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CODES, RECOMMENDATIONS GUIDELINES AND OTHER NON-MANDATORY INSTRUMENTS

- 1 For the purpose of encouraging Member States to provide information on the status of implementation of codes, recommendations, guidelines and other safety related non-mandatory instruments, the Maritime Safety Committee, at its seventy-ninth session (1 to 10 December 2004), invited Member Governments to transmit to the Secretariat relevant information on the implementation of such instruments.
- Member Governments are requested to advise the Organization of the current status of their implementation of the aforementioned instruments. The list of selected codes, recommendations, guidelines and other safety related non-mandatory instruments was last reviewed by the Committee at its sixty-sixth session (28 May to 6 June 1996) and is reproduced at annex, as updated.
- The information requested should be forwarded to the Secretariat and updated on a regular basis in order to keep the Committee duly informed about the status of such instruments, once every two years, at the first session of the Committee following every Assembly session.
