CLASSIFICATION

Croatian Register of Shipping (CRS) is a member of International Association of Classification Societies (IACS) – a top leading group of classification societies covering 90% of the world's carrying tonnage.

CRS is also a recognized classification society by the European Parliament and the European Council as regards common rules and standards for ship inspection and survey organizations.

CRS mission in the field of classification certification is to promote the highest internationally adopted standards as regards protection and safety of life and property at sea and to protection of the sea environment.

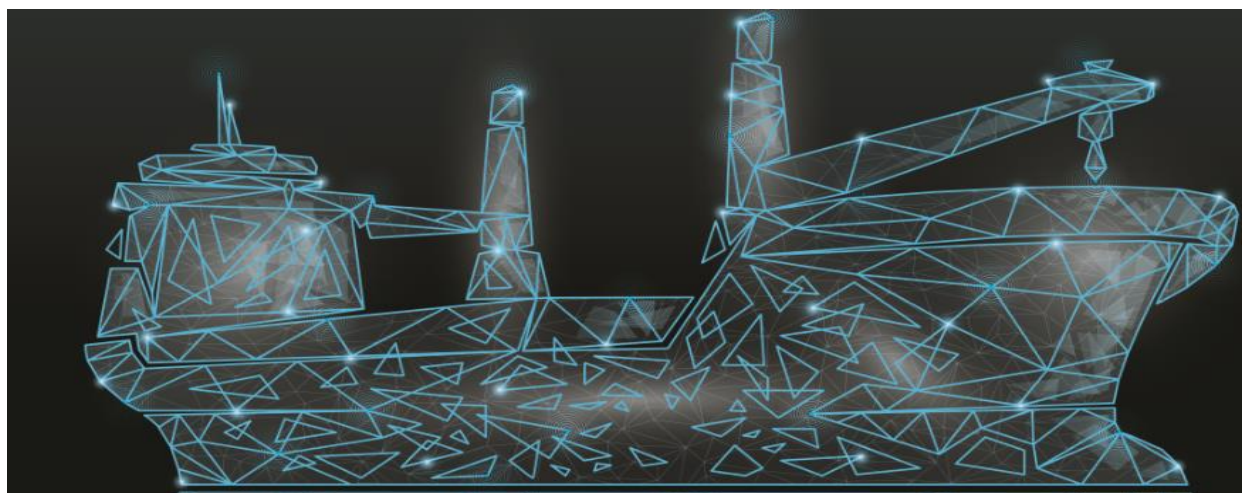
STATUTORY CERTIFICATION

CRS has been granted authorization by all the major Flag State administrations for different aspects of statutory certification such as surveys, approvals and certification services. These authorizations are stipulated by the international and national regulations on marine safety and environmental protection. They also include regulations set by IMO (International Maritime Organization) and ILO (International Labour Organization).



NEWBUILDING CLASSIFICATION

CRS Rules are appropriate for design and construction of a wide range of merchant, passenger and naval vessels. Our classification services include plan approval of newbuilding design, surveys at shipyard, certification of materials and equipment at the manufacturer and the final stage that consists of witnessing the sea trials to evaluate compliance with the valid classification and statutory rules.



CERTIFICATION OF MATERIALS AND COMPONENTS

Materials and components built-in a vessel must conform to specific technical standards. These apply to different materials, welding consumables, engine components, lifting appliances, electrical and automation systems, navigation and fire safety equipment, and many other systems. Certification of vessel components according to different standards and regulations ensure vessels to be safer and more reliable.

CRS reviews the technical documentation that defines your product type, recommends the appropriate test program and helps you to obtain your Type Approval Certificate.

MED Certification

CRS covers the full scope of MED certification for: Navigation equipment, Radio-communication equipment, Life-saving appliances, Fire protection equipment, Marine pollution prevention equipment, COLREG 72 and SOLAS II-1 equipment.

CAP: CONDITION ASSESSMENT PROGRAMME

CRS CAP comprises document evaluation of the actual condition of ship's structures, mechanical installation, machinery, systems and electric equipment for third parties involved in the vessel's operation.

CAP is a tool for quality assessment of the ship and ship's elements, irrespective of age in accordance with the established rating system.

Oil tankers and bulk carriers CAP procedures are kept continuously updated to respond to the industry needs.

OFFSHORE

CRS performs statutory certification of fixed offshore installations (fixed offshore platforms and submarine pipeline systems) which include:

- design appraisal
- manufacturing survey during fabrication offshore installation survey
- survey during pre-commissioning and commissioning
- in-service periodic surveys and inspections

CRS performs regular periodic surveys and certification of fixed gas offshore platforms and related submarine pipelines in the Adriatic Sea (Croatia).

CRS performs surveys during fabrication and construction of liquid and gas transportation systems and their storage plants in accordance with statutory regulations and international standards.



INDUSTRY

CRS is EU Notified Body NB 2489 and is authorized to perform conformity assessments and periodic inspections in accordance with:

- Pressure Equipment Directive 2014/68/EU (PED), for all PED conformity modules: A2/B/C2/D/D1/E/E1/F/G/H/H1 and for approval of permanent joining procedures.
- Simple Pressure Vessels Directive 2014/29/EU (SPVD), for all SPVD conformity modules: B/C/C1/C2.
- Directive 2010/35/EU (TPED) on transportable pressure equipment: pressure receptacles, their valves and other accessories from chapter 6.2 of ADR/RID, tanks, battery vehicles/wagons, multiple-element gas containers (MEGC), their valves and other accessories from chapter 6.8 of ADR/RID.

As a recognized organization by the Republic of Croatia in accordance with IMDG Code and CSC Convention, CRS is authorized for:

- individual or type approval of containers,
- supervision during manufacture and testing of containers,
- approval of container manufacturers and testing institutions,
- survey of containers in use.
