Rules for technical supervision of sea-going ships, Part 22 – Pollution prevention, edition November 2023, are including the following amendments:

1. **SECTION 3 – PREVENTION OF POLLUTION BY NOXIOUS LIQUID SUBSTANCES IN BULK**
Introduction of the Amendments to MARPOL Annex II from MEPC 78.
2. **SECTION 6 – PREVENTION OF POLLUTION BY GARBAGE**
Introduction of the Amendments to MARPOL Annex V from MEPC 79, including requirements for Garbage Record Book to be placed on board ships of 100 GT and above not later than 1 May 2024 (MEPC.360(79)).
3. **SECTION 7 – PREVENTION OF AIR POLLUTION**
Introduction of the Amendments to MARPOL Annex VI from MEPC 78 and MEPC 79.
4. **SECTION 8 – CONTROL OF HARMFUL ANTI-FOULING SYSTEMS ON SHIPS**
Inclusion of the requirements of MEPC.358(78) - 2022 Guidelines for Survey and Certification of Anti-Fouling Systems on Ships, MEPC.356(78) - 2022 Guidelines for brief sampling of anti-fouling systems on ships, and MEPC.379(80) - 2023 Guidelines for the development of the inventory of hazardous materials, related to cybutryne if found on board.
